Sat., Sept. 20 **Copland's** *Appalachian Spring*, **Gershwin's** *An American in Paris* and *Rhapsody in Blue*, plus **Leroy Anderson's** *Piano Concerto* performed by this season's Johnson Distinguished Guest Artist, Jeffrey Biegel .

Sat., Oct. 11 In his *Sixth Symphony*, **Mahler** expressed joy, love, loss and fate. Gilbert Kaplan, a leading international authority on Mahler, and Juilliard faculty member, will be present to share compelling stories about Mahler's life and discuss how those aspects of his life are played out through the music. He's a "Mahler Scholar!"

Fri., Nov. 21 **Saint-Saëns** *Symphony No. 3* and the **Poulenc** *Organ Concerto* will bring Dan McKinley back to Columbus to "pull out all the stops" on the magnificent Aeolian-Skinner organ at First Christian Church. **Richard Strauss'** *Also sprach Zarathustra* is better known today as the 2001 Space Odyssey theme. *Fantasia on a Theme of Thomas Tallis* by **Ralph Vaughan Williams** is on many "favorites" lists.

Sun., Dec. 7 This year, the holiday concert is back on the first Sunday of December. There will be surprises for the children and lots of old fashioned, traditional music to help you "Unwrap the Joy."

Sat., Feb. 7 Steve Lippia's 2007 performance as "Ol' Blue Eyes" was a sell-out. Ensure your seat for this concert by buying season tickets. "That's Entertainment" will include music of **Hoagy Carmichael** and **Cole Porter**.

Sat., April 4 *Missa Solemnis* by **Beethoven** is a "giant" in choral/orchestral music. The Philharmonic Orchestra and Chorus will share the stage with 100 additional singers performing this joyful and uplifting masterpiece.

Sat., April 25 One of our favorite violinists, Barnabás Kelemen, caps the season when he returns to perform the **Brahms** *Violin Concerto*. This time he will be joined by his talented wife, Kati, and together they perform the **Mozart** *Sinfonia Concertante*. Eighteen years ago the "hit" of the season was *Don Juan* by **Strauss**. We think you will enjoy hearing it again.
