Travel compensation for the 24/25 CIP season is \$.38 per mile for a max of \$55 per round trip.

Applicants will be pre-screened based on resume, and may or may not be invited to a live audition. All applicants will play behind a screen for all rounds.

<u>All applicants should prepare the following:</u>

Solo Repertoire

J.S. Bach: Any single movement from any of the Cello Suites, in either the original or transcribed keys.

AND

Exposition of the first movement of a concerto from the standard repertoire.

We encourage candidates to perform their selected concerto with standard orchestral tuning. We do not expect candidates to employ scordatura.

Bach	Orchestral Suite No. 2 BWV 1067	Badinerie
Beethoven	Symphony no. 5	Mvt III: beginning – 5 m. after Reh A; pick-up to m. 141 – m. 218 (no repeat)
Brahms	Symphony no. 2	Mvt I: Reh E – Reh F
Mozart	Symphony no. 40	Mvt I: 4th beat of m. 114 – 134 downbeat (20 before C to downbeat of C)
Strauss	Ein Heldenleben	Reh 9 – 6 m. after Reh 12
Tchaikovsky	Symphony no. 4	Mvt I: Reh P – 2nd m. after Reh Q

Copies of all the orchestral excerpts will be emailed to applicants.

Candidates may play from their own copies.

Candidates will need to procure their own copies of all solo repertoire.
